## **QCBFD TRASH/RECYCLING COLLECTION**

For the second year in a row the Community Property Committee (CPC) went out to bid for a replacement of our trash/recycling contractor. Requests for bids were sent to multiple companies. The Board of Governors was presented with the various proposals and elected to award the multi-year contract to Steve Piccolo and sons. We were able to obtain a contract that will allow year-round collection with significant savings over EZ Waste the previous company, mainly due to pricing of "season" vs "year-round." This year round service was very helpful to the community as many residents decided to quarantine in place at Quonnie. We were also able to provide twice a week pick-up during July and August.

## **QCBFD PROPERTY MAINTENANCE**

QCBFD went out to bid for landscaping to secure a contractor to perform the community's regular maintenance, which includes mowing and trimming of the ball field, playground, tennis, shuffleboard and basketball courts, pump house, boat landing, beach right-of-way and roadside maintenance. We are now contracting with Jon Pruitt of General Landscape. Jon Pruitt has been responsive to special requests and worked with the board on projects in a timely and efficient manner.
