As part of our exceptional trash and recycling service, Steve Piccolo and Son Trash Haulers will pick up trees, free of ornaments and tinsel, sometime between the middle and end of January. He has asked them to be left on the side of the drive viewable from the road, and he will collect them and take them to be composted.

Reminders for homeowners

Pickup service is every Monday. During the months of July and August there will be an additional Friday pick-up.

ALL GARBAGE MUST BE PLACED IN PLASTIC BAGS WITHIN TIGHT FITTING GARBAGE CANS.

Refuse must be in tight fitting containers that are animal proof. Bags have been left on the side of the road and have been torn into by animals. No one

wants to have to clean up someone else's mess. Please

**ALL RECYCLABLES SHOULD BE OPEN IN A
RECYCLE BIN – NO PLASTIC BAGS.**

This may seem confusing but recycling is handled differently than garbage. By town ordinance, all households are required to recycle. RI state website for information regarding recycling rules:

The weekly refuse collection service will not pick up anything but normal household trash. Things like brush, furniture, grass clippings, boat parts and such must be taken to the town dump. A permit is required or homeowners may contact any hauler to arrange for a special pick up.
