**Water Storage back on Line**

Dear QCBFD,

**The water storage tank went back online Wednesday afternoon. There are no water use restrictions in place beyond the usual. We still ask folks to respect the community agreed restriction of ONLY Handheld Watering meaning No UNATTENDED LAWN WATERING OR SPRINKLERS.**

**Even though the water tank was properly sterilized prior to placement online, as previously mentioned, we elected to voluntarily institute a Provisional Boil Water Advisory (PWBA).**

**This PWBA was provided in an earlier e-blast with all the required RIDOH language. Just to be clear, no bacteria have been found in our water.**

**The PBWA will remain in place until lifted by RIDOH. RIDOH will do so upon review of the certified lab reports of our water samples to be taken over the next 2 days. Expect the PWBA NOT to be lifted until next Monday or Tuesday.**

**I will alert the community when that occurs.**

**National Grid will have a crew in Central Beach to trim vegetation from the power lines. Long overdue! They have probably already contacted most homeowners. They may begin work as early as this Friday, May 13th and into most of next week.**

**Please be aware; some road access may be temporarily compromised as the crews work.**
