As reported in several prior e-blasts, the Rhode Island Department of Health (RIDOH) requires all Public Water System (PWS) operators to develop a Cross-Connection Control Plan and to submit a Cross-Connection Control Report by December 30, 2019.

This was also a condition of our recent Level 2 Assessment specifically requesting documentation that any private wells in QCBFD are not cross-connected to the PWS.

"Cross-Connection" means an actual or potential connection between any parts of a PWS and any source of contamination or pollution.

We ask the community read the CCC Brochure prepared by RIDOH for more information.

To ensure we are in compliance with this request, and to document our progress towards developing a Cross-Connection Control Plan, the Public Works Committee is requesting all home owners review and submit responses to a survey which can be found here

We ask for a response by November 1, 2019. We must have 100% participation in this request to allow for a timely submission of the required Cross-Connection Control Report to RIDOH.

This is only the first step towards compliance with the RIDOH Cross-Connection Control Plan. In 2020 we will need to confirm property connections are in compliance. Responses from this survey will allow the Public Works Committee to develop a strategy of how best to proceed.
