**Dear Greetings!**

**Following up on last week's water update, I wish to remind everyone that this afternoon and tomorrow, Tuesday and Wednesday, chlorine levels in the distribution system will be elevated. You may smell chlorine.**

**Please consider modifying your laundry schedules and if chlorine is unpleasant to you consider drinking bottled water.**

**Remember that the mandated RIDOH Boil Water Advisory is still in place.**

**Weather forecasts suggest a HARD freeze this Friday evening with temperatures dropping to 20 degrees F which is well below freezing! Each year we invariably have a property or 2 within QCBCFD with frozen indoor or outdoor pipes.**

**Please assure ALL your outdoor showers and plumbing are drained and shutoff. Further, if your home is not winterized, be particularly aware and take steps to protect your property from a frozen pipe. You were warned last week!**

**If you utilize a whole house shutoff, i.e. the water is actually shut off, you will experience priceless peace of mind knowing that your home is not the source should we send out an alert about an ongoing community water leak!**
