 - a. Lucas. Bayview. Kenyon were not chip sealed. Contractor paid 80% of billed amount. Will try to schedule chip seal of remaining roads and sweep the gravel.
 - b. Speed bump placement West Niantic by Kenyon and on Lucas.Committee will look for location on Lucas. Discussed hump vs bump
- 3. Discussed water pooling on W. Niantic from recent construction, Donovan property contractor and abutting neighbors seem to have coordinated a fix. Will reevaluate next spring.
- 4. Informational update on nitrate water level. water usage and possible action on water system repairs
 - a. Nitrate level stable@3.0July3rd pending August
 - b. Recent TC+ wells underwent Levell assessment. No obvious cause. Wells and tank chlorinated per RIDOH protocol.
 - c. Electrical voltage fluctuations caused well 1 breakers to trip several times. Breakers replaced with 17 amp rating, NWSI will have electrical engineer evaluate the power source.
- 5. Discussion and possible action regarding NWSI contract
 - a. 7.5% increase seems agreed to. NWSI offer 5% reduction of excess charges hourly rate from 95lhr to 90.25/hr.
