## Minutes of Emergency Meeting

## Quonochontaug Central Beach Fire District Public Works Committee held on April 15, 2020 at 9:00 a.m. Via Zoom Videoconference (COVID RELATED)

## Meeting Called to Order 9:00AM

- Motion made and seconded and passed unanimously for approval of emergency meeting to rapidly disseminate and discuss the 4/10/2019 RIDOH meeting in advance of RIDOH CAP revision.
- 2. RIDOH wanted to hear of progress re well field regrading and plans for 4-log disinfection based on their proposed CAP timeline
  - a. We shared the three consultants differing position, our inability to rapidly achieve 4-log plans as we need to see the iron remediation plans and will need to enlarge pumphouse which will require DEM/CRMC approval and permitting processes.
  - b. We did not feel timeline presented was reasonable.
- 3. RIDOH feels the well field is permanently contaminated, citing elevated nitrate levels, and will not allow discussion of non 4-log path forward.
  - a. We respectfully disagreed and would discuss with our engineers a path forward and timeline but the proposed timeline was not in line with our consultants recommendations and also not in line with Fire District procedural requirements
- 4. Addition of UV disinfection in anticipation of 4-log chlorination was raised; RIDOH vehemently opposed a UV system. After discussion a concession for CB to submit UV plans, as an adjunct to 4-log Chlorination, was allowed with the caveat that engineering resources were stretched and the plans might not be reviewed.
- 5. RIDOH said they would revise the Corrective Action Plan and get back to CB within 1-2 weeks.
- 6. PW Meeting discussed various paths forward including importANce of proceeding with pumphouse enlargement plans and submission of UV modification plans as an adjunct to chlorine disinfection (as per RIDOH request)..
- 7. Motion to adjourn made and seconded at 9:54
