QCBFD Beach Rules and Regulations

Blatant eating and drinking on the beach this past week were disturbing to many of our residents; 'concealed' eating too! Both residents and their guests as well as unknowns were in violation of the Beach Rule: NO EATING AND DRINKING ON THE BEACH.

Additionally, your trash , pizza boxes, and glass bottles were either left in the parking lot or at the beach attendant's block for other residents to dispose of.

A REMINDER:

No coolers, food or beverages shall be brought onto the beach. No food of any kind, no cans, no bottles. Yes water is allowed on the beach; eating in the parking lot is permitted as long as you take away your trash! No trash to be left in the beach parking lot and/or at the block. This includes pizza boxes, broken beach toys, bottles, food containers, etc...

The rule applies to ALL on the QCBFD beach - whether you are an owner, an owner's offspring, a renter, or a guest!

For QCBFD residents, it is important you review these rules with your family members and guests.

For QCBFD residents who rent, it is important you review these rules with your renters and their guests.
