40th Annual Fun Run Results



Thank you to all of the 40th Annual Quonnie Fourth of July Four Mile Fun Run and "Lil" Fun Participants. This was a record year for entrants (284) and Finishers (203), plus 27 runners below 10 years old for our 1st Annual "Lil" Fun Run.

There were 5 runners who were over 70 years old with our oldest runner at 81 years old. Our youngest runner in the Four Mile race was 6 years old, with our youngest "Lil" Fun Runner at 3.5 years old. Our runners registered from 96 different cities in 17 states. What a community we have in Quonnie!

All water systems in Rhode Island are required to prepare what's known as this Consumer Confidence Report (CCR) annually for the full previous year and distribute it by the end of June in the present year. Our CCR is prepared by the Atlantic States Rural Water and Wastewater Association of which we

are a member. It's a technical analysis of our water and explains in some detail what exists in the water and at what levels.

Essentially it's telling us that the water is fine except the nitrate level exceeded 5.0 ppm for the month of November 2015. The nitrate level is currently below 3.0 ppm. Please read the item in the report regarding nitrates that is located just below the "2015 TEST RESULTS". We will be providing an update regarding this subject, including possible correction action, at a later date. We test every month for bacteria and nitrates at both wells and at a enduser's location, monthly for orthophosphate to insure that our end user plumbing is adequately protected against the leaching of lead and copper, annually and every three years for a bunch of other stuff. The take away is that our public water is well scrutinized and the water is very safe.
